What we have done – 2'



Describe briefly the **process** you have gone through – who is in your team, what were the bottlenecks, the breakthroughs?



A team with Henry (Norway), Anna (Bulgaria), Hélène (France) and Anne (France)

We presented the challenge and made a new proposition: How to involve tenants (*locataires*) and social housing in an exemplary project of rehabilitation and redevelopment of the outside?

We decided to zoom on rehabilitation and redevelopment because we thought tenants had decision-making power over these issues.



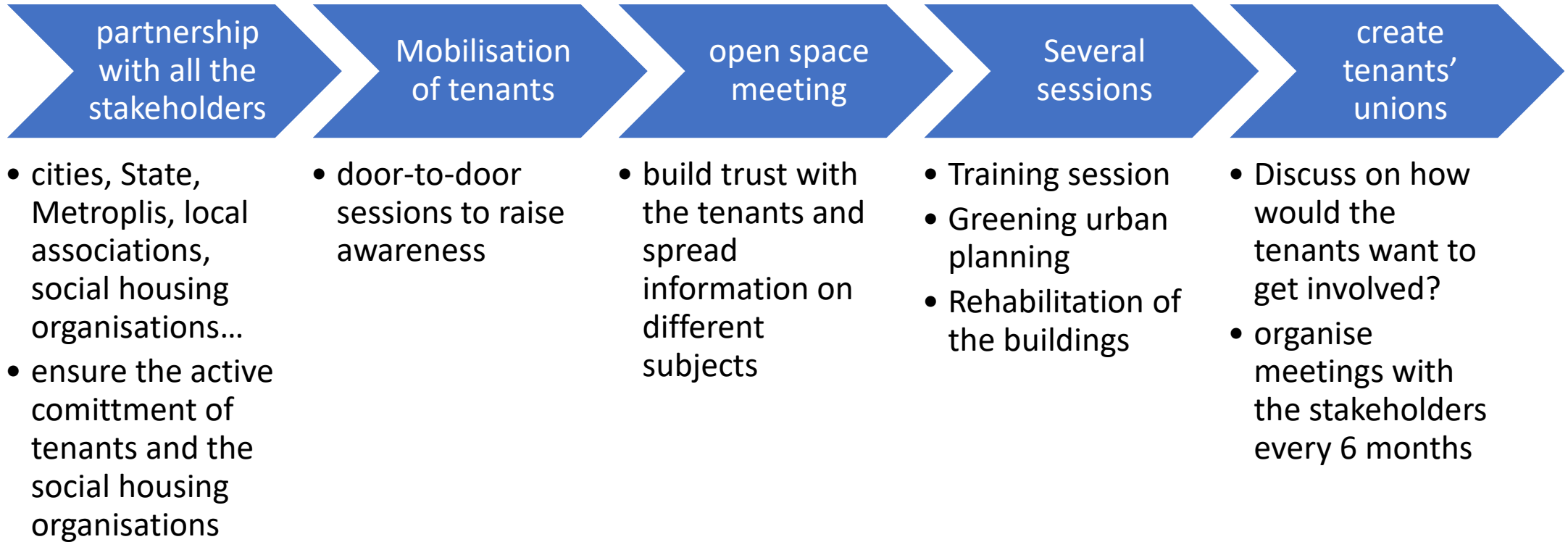
Our solution – 2'

Our final objective is to build tenants' capacity in different domains (like energy poverty, rehabilitation, greening urban planning) to go to future co-creation workshops

Our solution is a process with several steps:

1. Organize a partnership with all the stakeholders (cities, State, Metroplis, local associations, social housing organisations...) to ensure the active comittment of tenants and the social housing organisations in the planning and implementation of a comprehensive rehabilitation project
2. Mobilisation of tenants : door-to-door sessions to raise awareness
3. Create an open space meeting to build trust with the tenants and spread information on different subjects
4. Several sessions after the open space meeting:
 1. Training session on the main issues: energy poverty, neighborhood heat islands...
 2. Greening urban planning, co-design session
 3. Rehabilitation of the buildings, co-design sessions
5. Discuss on how would the tenants want to get involved? See how to create tenants' unions and organise meetings with the stakeholders every 6 months
