# What we have done – 2'



Describe briefly the **process** you have gone through – who is in your team, what were the bottlenecks, the breakthroughs?



## **Process:**

Started with brainstorming > approx. 40 ideas > narrow towards 1 concrete plan

## **Bottlenecks:**

- Some actions weren't under direct control of the challenge owner
- Too deeply into prototyping and forgot the initial problem

## **Breakthrough:**

- Focus on the soft challenges that can be executed by the challenge owner and his team
- Good support of the mentor – remembered us of the initial problem
- Diagram with 2 axis was very helpful; solutions connected to each other that let us choose

## Our solution – 2'



*How can we ensure that citizens' assemblies and other forms of participation become more than a one-off initiative, leaving a lasting impact on long-term climate policy and embedding citizen perspectives within ongoing governance?*

Solution title: *Creating Demand for Future Assemblies*

How?

1. Give positive publicity around te 9/10 chosen recommendations by **creating a label** and visual representation
2. Keeping it alive with internal/external ambassadors over time and by the city councillor on climate

## Action plan – 2'



*Starting on Friday, 28 March, we will discuss with the strategic manager what room we have and can occupy to execute this, and defining the roles and tasks of all stakeholders*



Time-path: 1,5-2 years (ensuring continuity over legislature period)

Succes:

- Future candidates use this idea in their program
- Public talks about assemblies
- City recognizes the implementation of the advises
