

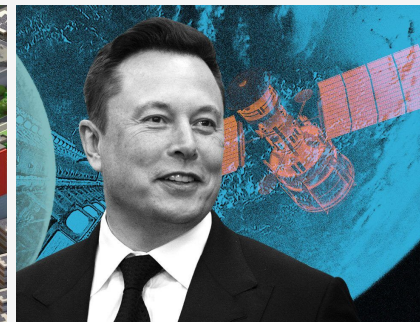
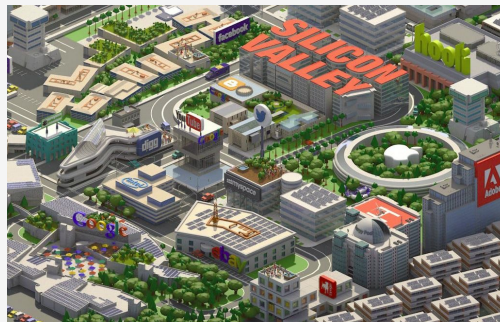
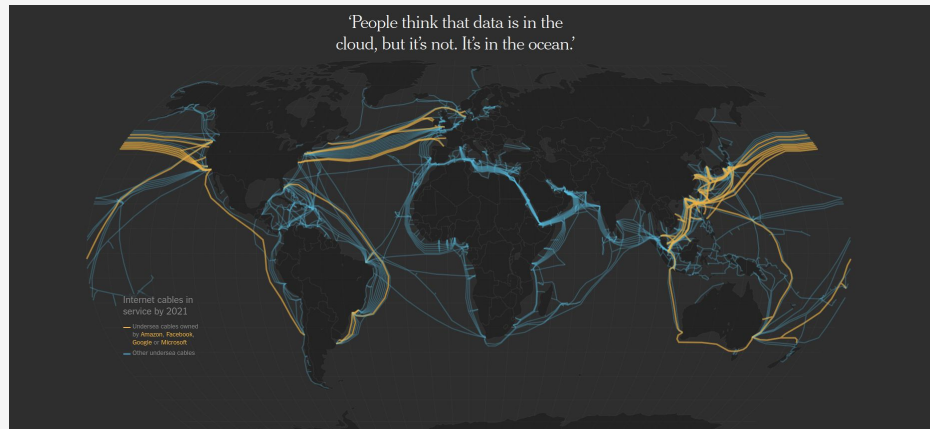

- * People and rights first

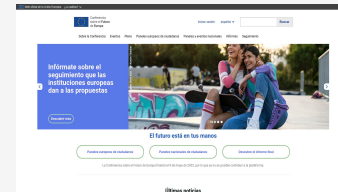


Decidim, a global digital platform for democracy

- * 500 Installations, 3 Million participants, 30 countries, 300 public organisations.
- * Technology with democratic guarantees
- * New model for public-common technologies

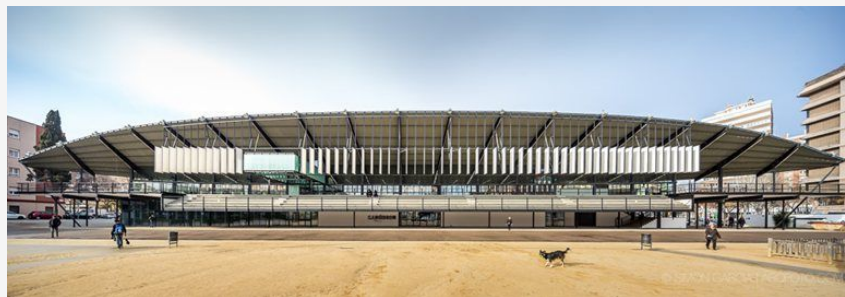
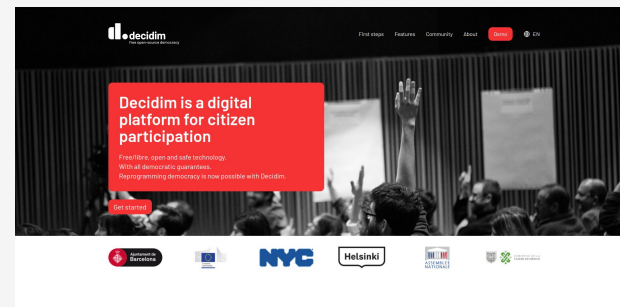
